





RESIDENT & COMMUNITY SPECIFIC NEEDS



 Ways to move and evacuate residents based on building layout

- NH included in facility assessment
- Review of each resident and ability to self-evacuate

WRITTEN AGREEMENTS

Transportation : to ensure the continuity of services to residents in the event o limitations or cessation of operations.

Receiving sites: to ensure evacuation to a safe location
